

Setup Email on Smart Device



Example Case: Android Device (Jelly Bean/Kit Kat), Type: IMAP.

*For Apple devices, carry out the initial few steps accordingly.

Note: The port numbers used in this document is default. If your email server has different values, please use accordingly.

Default Values - IMAP Port: 993, POP3 Port: 995, SMTP Port: 465

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make Username same as the Email address. • Set the IMAP server same as the Incoming Server Address. • Select Security type as SSL (Accept all certificates). • Set IMAP Port as in the above setting table. • Go Next. <p>The device will check the Incoming Server settings and if valid you will be directed to next screen.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set the SMTP server same as the Outgoing Server Address. • Select Security type as SSL (Accept all certificates). • Set SMTP Port as in the above setting table. • Go Next. <p>The device will check the Outgoing Server settings and if valid you will be directed to next screen.</p>
